Who Killed Goldfinger? (3 x 60mins) Sky Docs

Documentary series with drama recon about the life and mysterious death of John “Goldfinger” Palmer, once Britain’s richest criminal.

Miriam: Death of a Reality Star (3 x 60mins) Channel 4

Documentary series with drama recon telling the story of transgender reality TV star, Miriam Rivera.

The Essex Murders (3 x 60mins) Sky Docs

Documentary series with drama recon re-examining the murder of three drug dealers following the death of Leah Betts from an ecstasy overdose, against the backdrop of the 90s rave and crime scene.

The Chameleon Killer (4 x 60mins) Discovery ID

Documentary with drama reconstruction about one of the USA’s most notorious serial killers.

Exposed: The Church’s Darkest Secret (2 x 60mins) BBC2

Documentary with drama reconstruction about Bishop Peter Ball and sexual abuse in the Church of England.

Love and Hate Crime (3 x 60mins) BBC3 / BBC1

Second series of documentaries about hate crime in the US told through three murders.

Our Fallen (1 x 90mins) Discovery ID

Telling the story of three mass shootings in the US through testimony from survivors and the families of victims (edit only).

Paras: Ready for War (3 x 60mins) ITV1

Observational documentary following a year in the life of a parachute regiment.

Dispatches: Homeless and Working (1 x 30mins) C4

Investigating the rapid increase in the numbers of working people who are homeless.

Knickerbockerglory (Oct 2016 – Aug 2017)

Gypsy Kids: Our Secret World (8 x 60mins) C5

Return of the series taking an inside look at the life of Travellers through the eyes of the children.

Celebrities in Therapy (6 x 60mins) C5

Six more celebrities undergo counselling with renowned therapist, Mandy Saligari.

Studio Lambert (Sept 2015 – June 2016)

Big Life Fix (3 x 60mins) BBC2

Seven of the UK's top scientists and engineers come up with bespoke inventions for people and communities in need. Presented by Simon Reeve.

Walk The Line (1 x 60mins pilot) BBC2

Coast meets Treasure Hunt as two teams compete to walk five miles in an exact straight line - through rivers, forests and even people's houses - between two iconic British landmarks.

RDF Television (2002 – 2015)

Sun, Sex and Suspicious Parents (series 4 and 5) BBC3

The hit format where parents spy on their teenager's first holiday. Filmed in European holiday resorts, Thailand, UK music festivals and a one-off episode for Freshers' week.

The Greatest Shows on Earth (4 x 60mins) C4

Presenter Daisy Donovan travels to Egypt, Saudi Arabia, India, Brazil and South Korea looking at some of the most popular television shows in the world to explore how they reflect the societies that watch them.

Secrets of the Shoplifters and Pickpockets (2 x 60mins) C4

Undercover with police in South Yorkshire and the London Underground as they play cat and mouse with shoplifters and pickpockets, revealing the secret tricks of the trade.

Cutting Edge Freaky Sleepers: Sex, Texts and Terrors (1 x 60mins) C4

One off documentary looking at the new wave of extraordinary stress-related sleep disorders, following several patients as they seek treatment and talk about the physical and mental impact of their condition.

Secret Millionaire (series 3 – 7) C4

Millionaire benefactors go undercover in deprived areas around the country and donate money to charities and individuals that need their help.

Mind Your Manners (5 x 30mins) C4

Two uncouth families compete to see who can improve their etiquette and manners, with guidance from former Ladette to Lady presenters, Gill Harbord and Rosemary Shrager.

Stop Treating Me Like a Kid (6 x 60mins) E4

A group of pampered teenagers are put in a house for six weeks to find out if they have what it takes to live an adult life.

Celebrity Wife Swap (1 x 60mins) C4

Vanessa Feltz and Paul Daniels swap lives and spouses for a week.

Holiday Showdown (series 5 and 6) ITV

Two families with very different ideas of what makes a good holiday go away together and try to convince each other of the wonders of their destination.

Bomber Crew (4 x 60mins) C4

Telling the story of the role of Bomber Command during World War Two through interviews with veterans and archive footage. Descendants of veterans also undertook the training their grandfathers did using the last remaining airworthy bomber aircraft in Europe.

Spitfire Ace (4 x 60mins) C4

The story of the Battle of Britain told through interviews with veterans and archive footage. Four young pilots also trained in Tiger Moths before getting to fly an actual Spitfire.
